Symbolizing the centrality of our Catholic faith, the Oratory of Ave Maria is situated in the center of this unique community, connecting town housing and shops with Ave Maria University's buildings and green spaces. The 27,000 square foot Oratory seats 1,100 people in a traditional Catholic church plan.

The Oratory's design is rooted in historic church forms, rendered with contemporary structure, materiality, and technology. Exterior materials include a mixture of limestone, steel buttresses, metal cladding, and skylights. The interior details incorporate stone, bronze, wood, and glass in compositions reminiscent of Frank Lloyd Wright's designs. Inside and out, the Oratory is a celebration of the Catholic religion, beckoning residents and students to this heart of the Ave Maria community.
