

# MICHIGAN HOMESCHOOLED FAITH SCHOLARSHIP

*"Homeschooled" is defined here as taught at home and applies to those independently homeschooled as well as those enrolled in national homeschool programs (such as Kolbe Academy, Mother of Divine Grace, and Seton Home Study).*

## \$9,000

- ◆ \$9,000 yearly / \$4,500 per semester
- ◆ This scholarship is in addition to standard institutional aid.
- ◆ For a duration of up to 4 years as an undergraduate student

### REQUIREMENTS:

- ◆ Applicant must be a resident of the state of Michigan.
- ◆ Applicant must be a first-time college freshman with a high school GPA of 2.8 (unweighted) or above; and an ACT score of 23 or above, or a SAT score of 1140 or above, who is accepted for admission at Ave Maria University for Fall 2021.
- ◆ Applicant must be a practicing Catholic with endorsement letter from home parish.
- ◆ Applicant must maintain a university GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- ◆ Applicant must have been homeschooled 9<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- ◆ This scholarship may not be combined with any other regional or donor funded scholarship.
